- Pray for the schools in our town. Pray for the protection of students, for wisdom for the schools leadership team, and give thanks for those who teach.

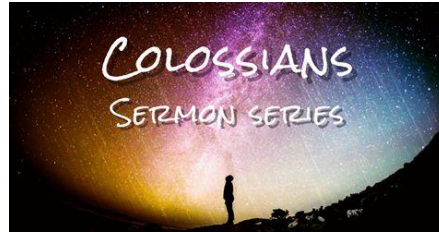
