the working with children CheCK

Working With Children Check especially for those who are in ministry positons, Brook Kids leaders and SRE Teachers.

There have been some changes to the laws around the **Working With Children Check** important for anyone who works or volunteers with kids and their employers.

Personal details must be updated Everyone who holds a Check is now legally required to update their contact details, including any name or address changes, within three months – just like your driver licence. And like your licence, penalties will apply for people who don't update. Updating your details is simple – go towww.kidsguardian.nsw.gov.au/check and follow the directions.

Renewal is Due The first Working With Children Check clearances issued in June 2013 will be due to expire. You can renew your WWC number from three months before its expiry date. And you will receive a reminder when it's time to renew - provided your contact details are up to date. Please email the church office when your renewal is complete.
