Jesus better than Angels

Main idea: The Author wrote that Jesus is better than Angels. Why? Well in the Old Testament Angels are seen as messengers, who bring a message from God. And Angels are seen likewise in the New Testament. And like the Angels and like the prophets Jesus brings to us a message from God. A message that we have been waiting for, and a message that we need to listen to.

Hebrews series week three – 12th August - Hebrews ch2

Jesus fully man

Main idea: That Jesus being higher than angels and fully man makes him the perfect facilitator to restore us to God.

Hebrews series week four - 19th August - Hebrews ch3

Jesus Better than Moses

Main idea: Moses was a faithful servant, but Jesus is better. Moses was a servant but Jesus owns the house.

Hebrews series week five – 2nd September - Hebrews ch4v14-5v10 and Chapter 7
Jesus our Kingly Priest

Main idea: Jesus fulfils both the roles of King and Priest.

Hebrews series week six - 9th September - Hebrews 8

The temple, a shadow of things to come!

Main idea: The Writer of Hebrews shows us the reason why the worship and focus of the New Testament is so radically spiritual, rather than ritualistic and traditionalistic. Jesus doesn't just fit into an earthly system but rather he has redefined its very nature.

Hebrews series week seven – 16th September - Hebrews 9

Why Blood?

Main idea: The concept of blood paying for wrongdoings is a concept that we today struggle with. So what do we do with a text like this? Skip it? Engage with it saying, hey! It may not resonate with us today but it did back then. Or do we allow it to speak to us? Whichever way you look at it the main point the writer of Hebrews is getting at is that Jesus is and perfect and final offering.
