### Hebrews series week thirteen – 28<sup>th</sup> October - Hebrews 12:18-29

The Puzzle unfolds.

Main idea: In this passage they compare two mountains: The first is Mt Sinai, the place where the law was given; and Mt Zion, or the city of Zion. The complete perfect kingdom of God. One is surrounded by fear and the feeling of being overwhelmed, the other is about Grace and mercy. It is the old vs the new. The central idea is that we do not need to approach Zion in the same way as Sinai because of what Jesus has done for us.

### Hebrews series week fourteen – 4<sup>th</sup> November - Hebrews ch13

F.I.A (Faith in Action)

Main idea: As the writer finishes this letter it seems like he has a list of things that he has run out of time to say. So here is dot point list. But if we look deeper we will see that this is actually a call to live out our theology.
