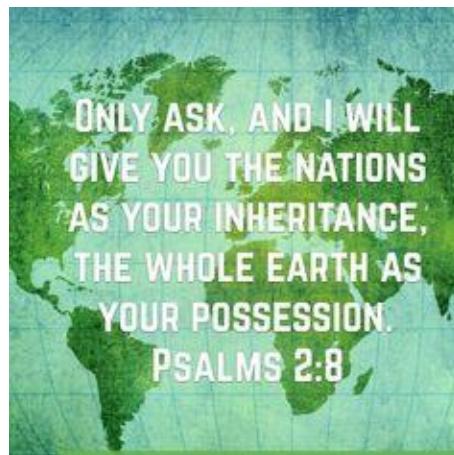

Previous weeks' notes and bible passages

Prophecies of Jesus' birth in the Psalms Week 1 – 18th November

Psalms about the Messiah birth and their New Testament counterparts:
The Messiah will come from the lineage of David (Psalm 89:3–4, 29–36; 132:11–17; Matthew 1:1).

The Messiah will come for all people (Psalm 18:49; Ephesians 3:4–6).

The Messiah will know His Father from childhood (Psalm 22:9; Luke 2:40).

The Messiah will be called by God while still in the womb (Psalm 22:10; Luke 1:30–33).

Prophecies of Jesus' birth in the Psalms Week 2 – 25th November

Psalm 22:9-10.
Prophecy in the bible comes in two different forms. *Fore telling*, this will happen in the future and *forth telling*, this is happening now and for this reason. Within prophecy there is this concept called typology. Typology is a “prophetic symbol” found in the Old Testament that foreshadows something future. For example Sampson is a typology, miraculous birth and a death that rescues God’s people is a foreshadowing of Jesus.
