

Previous weeks' notes and bible passages

Prophecies of Jesus' birth in the Psalms Week 2 – 25th November Psalm 22:9-10. Prophecy in the bible comes in two different forms. *Fore telling*, this will happen in the future and *forth telling*, this is happening now and for this reason. Within prophecy there is this concept called typology. Typology is a "prophetic symbol" found in the Old Testament that foreshadows something future. For example Sampson is a typology, miraculous birth and a death that rescues God's people is a foreshadowing of Jesus.

Prophecies of Jesus' birth in the Psalms Week 3 – 2nd December Psalm 2:6-8. Psalms about the Messiah Nature, and their New Testament counterparts The Messiah will be called King of the Jews (Psalm 2:6; John 12:12–13; 18:32). The Messiah will be the Son of God (Psalm 2:7; Luke 1:31–35; Matthew 3:16–17; Hebrews 1:5–6). 7. The Messiah will be Lord and King (Psalm 110:1a; Matthew 22:41–45). The Messiah is God (Psalm 45:6–7b; Hebrews 1:8–9). Others Psalms about the Messiahs Nature.

The Messiah will call God His Father (<u>Psalm 89:26</u>; <u>Matthew 11:27</u>). The Messiah will be God's only "begotten" Son (<u>Psalm 89:27</u>; <u>Mark 16:6</u>; <u>Colossians 1:18</u>; Revelation 1:5).

The Messiah will be eternal (<u>Psalm 102:25–27a</u>; <u>Revelation 1:8</u>; <u>Hebrews 1:10–12</u>). The Messiah is the creator of all things (<u>Psalm 102:25–27b</u>; <u>John 1:3</u>; <u>Ephesians 3:9</u>; <u>Hebrews 1:10–12</u>).

The Messiah will be a Priest after the order of Melchizedek (<u>Psalm 110:4</u>; <u>Hebrews 6:17–20</u>).

The Messiah will be the "Stone" rejected by the builders (<u>Psalm 118:22</u>; <u>Matthew 21:42–43</u>).

Parents' Group


