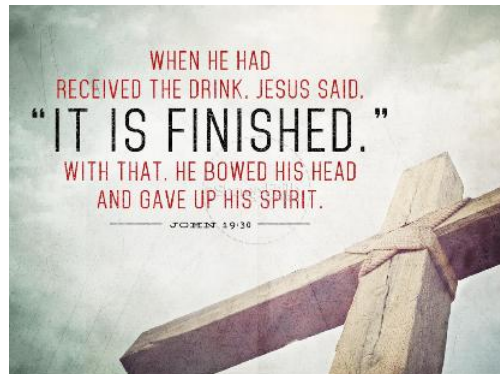

Stations of the Cross bible reading plan

Churches around the world be they catholic, protestant, conservative or charismatic take time to remember the final events of Our Lord, through a series of visual reminders known as the *Stations of the Cross*. The exact origin of the devotional use of The Stations of the Cross is not entirely clear; some historians associated it with a Christian pilgrimage to Jerusalem where those who were able to walk along the path Jesus walked, and reflected on the events that transpired on the way to his crucifixion. People were deeply moved by this experience. Yet, since the vast majority of Christians were not able to go to Jerusalem, The Stations of the Cross enabled them to engage in a mini-pilgrimage of sorts, whereby they could focus on the key events of Jesus' last day. We do not have statues, or visuals but we too can partake of this pilgrimage. Below is a list of Stations and their corresponding bible references. The idea is that you read the verse, picture yourself there, feel the weight and pray.

The First Station: Jesus on the Mount of Olives Luke 22:39-46

The Second Station: Jesus, Betrayed by Judas, Is Arrested Luke 22:47-48

The Third Station: Jesus is Condemned by the Sanhedrin Luke 22:66-71

The Fourth Station: Peter Denies Jesus Luke 22:54-62

The Fifth Station: Jesus is Judged by Pilate Luke 23:13-25

The Sixth Station: Jesus is Scourged and Crowned with Thorns Luke 22:63-65; John 19:2-3

The Seventh Station: Jesus Takes Up the Cross Mark 15:20

The Eighth Station: Simon of Cyrene Helps Jesus to Carry His Cross Luke 23:26

The Ninth Station: Jesus Meets the Women of Jerusalem Luke 23:27-31

The Tenth Station: Jesus is Crucified Luke 23:33-4, 47

The Eleventh Station: Jesus Promises His Kingdom to the Good Thief Luke 23:39-43

The Twelfth Station: Jesus on the Cross, His Mother, and His Disciple John 19:25-27

The Thirteenth Station: Jesus Dies on the Cross Luke 23:44-47

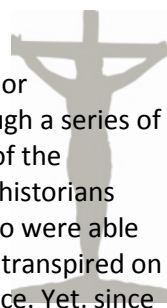
The Fourteenth Station: Jesus is Placed in the Tomb Luke 23:50-54; Mark 16:1-4
